LOCAL TALENT DEVELOPMENT Nomination:

NITE OUT with Mike Burns and Tara Donaghey

Background:

In March of 2010, local Stouffville artist Mike Burns approached Whistle Radio to solicit assistance in regard to an upcoming event to raise funds for disaster relief in Haiti. Burns

and fellow musicians Pierre Bordeleau, Andrew Heathcote and John McGouran joined together to host a "marathon open jam /open stage' to help raise funds.

WhiStle Radio immediately stepped up to the plate and program director at the time and show producer Tara Donaghey not only helped the quartet produce a number of PSA's she produced a half hour feature of the four musicians performing in the radio station's studio. The half hour special was broadcast



several times over the next few weeks to help garner interest in the event.

With the help of WhiStle Radio, the event raised over \$4,000.00 for disaster relief in Haiti. The money was donated directly to the Canadian Red Cross. The event itself showcased over 25 local performers as each got their turn to get up and strut their stuff on stage in front of a packed house.

As a result of this introduction, each of the performers were invited to appear live at various times on Tara Donaghey's weekly Friday broadcast "Weekend Warm-up", a program that leads into the weekend and was a variety type talk show.

In August of 2010, Mike Burns again approached WhiStle Radio with the idea for a radio show. The show would be a short entertainment magazine that would alert listeners as to what was going on in and around town. What artists or bands were playing where and even talk about the local eateries and things folks would like to know if they were considering a night out. The first working title of the show was "DATE NIGHT" and then settled into its weekly presentation as "NITE OUT". The show started as a half-hour broadcast hosted by Mike Burns and produced by Tara Donaghey.

Very quickly the idea was developed to invite in local musical artists that were performing locally within the coming period and help them promote their show or anything else. Each week the visiting artist was provided an opportunity to perform as well as being interviewed by Mike and Tara.

As the show moved into October, more and more artists were asking to be part of the NITE OUT program and in an effort to give the artists a better opportunity to show-case their talent – the show expanded to a one hour format.

In June of 2011, the show received sponsorship from a local business/restaurant that wanted the NITE OUT show to broadcast live from their roof—top patio every week (over the summer) in front of the restaurant's patrons. At that time the show became known as **NITE OUT with Mike Burns and Tara Donaghey** and expanded to a two hour format each Thursday night from 7:30 to 9:30 at the Cornerhouse on Main restaurant in Stouffville.



As before, the show featured performances by local artists each week and helped artists promote their upcoming shows or CD releases or other events in which they were involved.

Nomination Details:

- Over the past year and a half the NITE OUT show has featured performances by musical artists every week. Each week the artist participates in the show and promotes their CD or upcoming performance.
- In the past year, there have been over fifty featured artists appear on the NITEOUT program
- Since June of 2011, because the format of the show is two hours, the artist gets to perform about 10 to 12 songs.
- Although the show hosts are volunteers, the agreement negotiated by the hosts has the show's sponsor pay the artists a nominal fee for their appearance.
- Each week, the NITE OUT show features a Weekly Calendar that informs the
 community about who else is playing in and around town. Because the show has
 become friends with so many artists, the show hosts expand the geographical
 area it covers in the calendar if a friend of the show is playing out of town.
- WhiStle Radio has also forged partnerships with many other local ventures. Two
 of which are Stouffville.com (a local web based tourism and information site
 dedicated to the Town of Whitchurch Stouffville) and the Stouffville Free Press (a
 local independent news agency). In combination with these three links, NITE
 OUT publishes a weekly calendar on events. The calendar is provided in both a
 written format and an audio link that reviews upcoming events (available in the
 "entertainment" drop down menu at www.whistleradio.ca)
- Each appearing artist that has provided a CD of their material has had their material placed in the music rotation with the station.
- NITE OUT has arranged with two other local merchants that have electronic billboards at the front of their premises to advertise the name of which artist is appearing each week on the show
- Appearing on NITE OUT has resulted in many of the artists securing additional gigs and significant interest in relation to other performance opportunities.

Other Benefits:

As the hosts of NITE OUT have continued to grow its group of performing friends, and the successes experienced by those friends become known, a number of higher profile artists have offered there services to appear on the show. Although they are not local necessarily – their appearances increase listener-ship and thus have provided a bigger platform for our local talent pool.

Recent high profile artists to appear on our show;

- Canadian country recording artist Marshall Dane (Featured artist in the New Artist Showcase at the Canadian Country Music Award in 2011.)
- Canadian country music artist and local artist Leah Daniels (was also a featured artist on the New Artist Showcase for the 2010 CCMA's)
- Founder and front man with Coney Hatch, toured extensively with the Guess Who and April Wine – Carl Dixon
- World renowned classical guitarist and Professor of Music at York University – William Beauvais
- Interview with Canadian Actor/Comedian Bernard Robichaud (aka Cyrus from the Trailer Park Boys)

Upcoming Performances;

- Multi Juno award winning, Canadian Blues legend: Jack deKayser
- Canadian country recording artist and local talent Lindsay Broughton

In addition, as indicated previously, as a direct result of their appearance on NITE OUT many of our performers have acquired a number of local gigs and special events.



- Singer / song-writer Stouffville's own Morgan Sadler has been invited to be the opening act for a number of local events and is the opener for the Town of Whitchurch Stouffville's annual Strawberry Festival.
- Local duo of just out of high school buddies, KennedyClarke have acquired several gigs including being invited to perform at the B-Strong Foundation charity event in April.
- Singer / songwriter Carys Montgomery has also been invited t to the B-Strong event and has been asked to write the music and perform and record a special song in dedication to the foundation.

Further, the hosts of NITE OUT have used the popularity of the show and the lure of performing on the radio to fundraise for charity. The original four performers that got together for Haiti Relief in 2010 joined forces again and raised funds for Tsunami Distaster Relief for Japan in 2011 and hosted three open jam's to help raise money. The last installment of the fundraiser was broadcast live on NITE OUT and over \$1,000.00 was raised.





In July, of 2011, a member of the local police service was tragically killed in the line of duty. Once again, the NITE OUT team, sprung to action and hosted a fundraising open stage to help raise funds for the young officer's surviving children. NITE OUT broadcast live from the "Open Stage night" and 15 local artists performed. The event itself raised over \$4,000.00 for the charity. Once again the artists were thrilled to be able to perform live on the radio and many went on to secure numerous additional gigs as a result.

Conclusion:

Although the content and theme of the NITE OUT show continues to develop — interviews with other local well known people, the continued support of local restaurants and pubs, and fun stuff like trivia; all of these bring added listeners to the show — which helps promote the local talent we showcase each week — and that what it's all about — the local talent.


