This radio drama truly captures the Canadian experience for first and second generation Canadians.

Nkrabea's Destiny is the story of a strong black woman of noble birth. Nkrabea (pronounced

in-crabia), or Destiny in English, is forced to leave her Ghanaian village to become a lady of the night in the HIV infected streets of Kenya.
