About the program

Established in 2012, *The City* is a weekly one-hour radio program and podcast produced in Vancouver on unceded Coast Salish territory. Each week, the program provides an alternative look at our changing urban spaces. The program features news, interviews, discussions, documentaries, and music with a Vancouver focus and progressive analysis. The program showcases critical discussions of the people, politics, policies, and processes shaping urban geographies – on issues ranging from gentrification to indigenous rights, food security, economic change, urban social movements, and much more.

This edition of *The City* reflects on the Musqueam First Nation's struggle to protect their ancestral village site and burial grounds of <<cusnaum>> from condo development. This program episode documents Friday, August 10th, which marked 100 days of the Musqueam keeping an around-the-clock vigil and at the site under threat off development in south Vancouver. Musqueam marked 100 days with a march and a rally with other First Nations from around the province and many allies. The show features many different voices, including Musqueam members, politicians, and labour unionists.
