A Toronto reggae bandleader, in the 90's, Corby began dj-ing live at Harbour boat cruises and youth dances. Subbing in on CKLN.FM jazz, electro and pop shows, he championed multiple genres. With his own show he featured on-air artist performances, local listings and interviews with music promoters & aficionados.

All music revolves; it goes around and around – first on a turntable, and then in your mind. Corby's Orbit has a unique spin. Hosted by musician, educator and artist Paul Corby, the show tracks the trajectories of both instantly new classics, and durably old tunes. Amidst live, in-studio performances, cosmically comic patter and interviews, Corby manages to keep local Toronto area performances under constant exposure. Known for cutting edge curation and published support of Canadian talent (http://www.rootsmusic.ca/?s=corby), Corby also digs into international entertainment news, historical perspectives, poetic spoken word and campaigns of shameless idealism to further expand the revolutionary airspace and unwind the heavenly circlings.

At the outset of this decade, he decided to augment and corroborate his 30-month old radio show with a blog (http://dipaulcorby.blogspot.ca/). Publication of playlists was the priority at first. Soon, however, videos, political reality, rants, endorsements, elegies, phantasms, pirated images, and spiritual renovations began to fill up the cyberclubhouse of his internet hospitality suite. Approaching 25,000 hits, the Orbital reach now truly extends all the way around the planet.
